

GOLF AND CLUB HOUSE RULES

CLUB SUBSCRIPTIONS:

Subscriptions are due by 1st September. Any member whose subscription is in arrears shall be debarred from all club privileges.

DRESS:

Men and Ladies are requested to take pride in the club and maintain a responsible standard in respect to their attire in the club house and on the course. All members are requested to read the dress regulations displayed in the club house foyer.

COMPLAINTS:

All complaints shall be made to the Chief Executive Officer of the club, who, if unable to satisfy them, shall submit them to the General Golf Committee. If the complaint needs referral to the General Golf Committee, the complaint must be in writing so to avoid misinterpretation.

MEMBERS' RESPONSIBILITY:

Members are expected to conduct themselves in a manner that is respectful to the rights of

members and guests, club employees, visitors to enjoy the club. Members are expected to

respect club property, including the course and to adhere to any Code of Conduct put in

place by the Board of Directors of the club.

*All players **MUST** report to Pro Shop before commencing any round of golf.*

MEMBERS' GUESTS/PLAYING VISITOR/S:

The following conditions apply with the introduction of Members' guests who are playing visitor/s:

- a) A member shall not introduce more than three (3) playing visitor/s on any one occasion.
- b) A member must play with his or her visitor/s.
- c) No person shall be introduced as a member guest playing visitor/s on more than five (5) occasions in any one calendar year.
- d) A member introducing a visitor/s or guest to the club must do so in person at Pro Shop.
- e) A member shall not knowingly introduce as a visitor/s any person whose name has been expunged from the Register of Members of the club, or who has been refused admission to membership of the club or any other club.

NOTE: The above will not apply to Club Tournaments (see also by-law 5 of the Company Constitution re: local visitor/s).

ADVERSE WEATHER POLICY:

The Adverse Weather Policy addresses issues of extreme heat, lightning, strong winds and the need to suspend play when greens become unplayable due to heavy rain or other circumstances. The full Policy can be viewed on the Club Notice Board or please ask for a copy at the Pro Shop.

CLUB TOCUMWAL (CT) COURSE RENOVATIONS SCHEDULED FOR DECEMBER 2026.

Monday 17th, Tuesday 18th and Wednesday 19th of August 2026 - South Course Closed for Coring.

Monday 24th, Tuesday 25th and Wednesday 26th of August 2026 - North Course Closed for Coring.

CONDITIONS OF PLAY

1. All players **MUST** report to Pro Shop before commencing any round of golf.
2. **Ground Staff have right of way on the course at all times. Please await signal to proceed.**
3. Motorised Golf Buggies/Carts are to be kept at least **10 meters clear of any green.**
4. Inspect the Notice Board before start of play for temporary local rules and other information.
5. Practising on course: When practising on course, the maximum use of two golf balls only is permitted at any one time.
6. The putter head is not to be used to retrieve a ball from the hole.
7. It is the imperative duty (and it should be made a matter of pride) for all to see that divots are covered with sand and that the footprints in bunkers are made smooth and repair two pitch marks on each green played.
8. Bunker rakes should be placed in the **middle of bunkers**, lying in direction of play.
9. Players searching for a lost ball should promptly call the following players through, and having done this, should stand aside until these players have passed and are out of range.

You **ONLY** have three (3) minutes to look for your ball.
Under Golf Rule18.2, the time for a ball search.

10. Players **MUST** pick up as soon as a hole is lost in Par, or a point cannot be scored in any Stableford competitions.
11. When the result of a hole has been determined, players must leave the greens before marking their cards.
12. Each player will be responsible for the observance of the rules and etiquette of the game.

13. Motorised buggies are to be kept at least **10 metres clear of any green**.
14. **Pace of Play:** Play at Good Pace and Keep Up. Players should play at a good pace. The Committee may establish pace of play guidelines that all players should follow. It is a group's responsibility to keep up with the group in front. If it loses a clear hole and it is delaying the group behind, it should invite the group behind to play through, irrespective of the number of players in that group. Where a group has not lost a clear hole, but it is apparent that the group behind can play faster, it should invite the faster moving group to play through.

Be Ready to Play: Players should be ready to play as soon as it is their turn to play. When playing on or near the putting green, they should leave their bags or carts in such a position as will enable quick movement off the green and towards the next tee. When the play of a hole has been completed, players should immediately leave the putting green.

Lost Ball: If a player believes his ball may be lost outside a water hazard or is out of bounds, to save time, he should play a provisional ball. Players searching for a ball should signal the players in the group behind them to play through as soon as it becomes apparent that the ball will not easily be found. They should not search for three (3) minutes before doing so. Having allowed the group behind to play through, they should not continue play until that group has passed and is out of range.

15. Any Scorecard must be processed within 15 minutes of completing your round.

CONDITIONS OF MENS' COMPETITIONS

1. COMPETITIONS:

The Committee shall arrange and control all competitions and matches in consultation with the Director of Golf and their decision on all points connected therewith shall be final. Changes to the syllabus may occur if needed.

2. MONTHLY MEDAL:

Monthly Medal to be played for on the day allotted each month off the Black/White Markers. Open to all Full Financial Golf, Golf & Bowls members and Golf & Go members of Club Tocumwal Limited. The best score returned by a golfing member on that day shall be the Medal winner. In the event of a tie between two or more players, the count back system will be used to determine the winner.

3. STAR MEDAL:

The Star Medallist shall be played on the day allotted and time. **Sunday October 4th, 2026.** Winners of the Monthly Medal for the current year shall be eligible to play for the Star Medal. In the event of a tie the winner will be decided by the count back system.

4. THE CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP:

The Club Championship is a scratch event for Grades A,B,C & D Grades and is Open to all male Full Financial Golf, Golf & Bowls members and Golf & Go members of Club Tocumwal Limited. The championships will be played over four (4) rounds of stroke of play on the days allotted to the event.

In the event of a tie all grades will be decided by a hole-by-hole sudden death playoff, order of holes to be decided by the committee. Play to be from the Black Tees only for all four rounds.

Conditions of Entry for the CT Club Championships will be available on the Club Tocumwal website from July 2026.

- Tee times available to men on the first three (3) days of the championship.
- The top four players of each division Men & Women to be seeded on the final day. On the First tee. Gross Event Scores only.
- Scratch winners not eligible for overall handicap events.
- Daily events conducted in conjunction with the championships all (4) divisions.

Veterans 54 Holes Championships. Three (3) rounds of Stableford run concurrently.

Minor Championships to be played in four (4) divisions using the players current Golf Australia Handicap on the day of the first round of the championships.

5. MENS' MID-WEEK CHAMPIONSHIPS

The Mid-week Championship is a Stableford Competition Only. Grades will be determined after the first round of the event and is Open to all male golf members of all golf categories Full Financial Golf, Golf & Bowls members, Introductory, Country Members, Junior and Golf & Go Members of Club Tocumwal Limited. The championships will be played over three (3) rounds of Stableford play on the days allotted to the event.

Play to be from the Black Tees only for all three rounds. In the event of a tie all grades will be decided by the count-back system approved by GA.

Conditions of Entry for the Mid-week Championships will be available on the Club Tocumwal website from February 2026.

- Tee times available to men to book on all three (3) days of the championship.
- Daily events conducted in conjunction with the championships in all divisions, (determined on the day).

6. MIXED FOURSOMES CHAMPIONSHIP

Mixed Foursomes Championship is open to all CT full financial golf members. The qualifying round will be played on Saturday March 14th 2026 with the top eight pairs to qualify for match play competition. Open to all Full Financial Golf, Golf & Bowls members and Golf & Go members of Club Tocumwal Limited.

For the match play competition half (½) the difference in aggregate handicaps will apply (where a half-shot difference occurs the handicap shall be rounded up). In the event of a tie after 18 holes, the match will continue hole by hole, with handicap, until a decision is reached. Matches to be played on or before the DATES and TEE TIMES specified in the syllabus and tee sheets. Men will play from BLACK TEES and tee off on **ODD** numbered holes, ladies will play from GREEN TEES and tee off on **EVEN** numbered holes. The FINAL will be played on Saturday April 11th at 11.30am

7. TONY BALDWIN MEMORIAL SHIELD (sponsored by Baldwin Family):

The Tony Baldwin Memorial Shield Matchplay will be a 4BBB Stableford event and open to all Full Financial Golf, Golf & Bowls members and Golf & Go members of Club Tocumwal Limited.

The Tony Baldwin Memorial Shield qualifying round will be played on Sunday 19th April 2026.

Eight (8) pairs to qualify for the Matchplay rounds.

Round One Sunday 26th April. On or before

Semi-Final Sunday 3rd May. On or before

Final Sunday 17th May @ 11.30am

The Tony Baldwin Memorial Shield will be played from the BLACK TEES.

8. THE N & V WILSON TROPHY:

The N & V Wilson 27 Hole Foursomes Championship is open to all male Full Financial Golf, Golf & Bowls members and Golf & Go members of Club Tocumwal Limited. In the event of a tie in the Gross event, a sudden death playoff will occur on holes nominated and conducted by the GG Committee. Net event will be decided by the countback system. 27 Hole Foursomes Championship competition will be played in groups of six (6) as indicated and tee times allocated at the start of the daily tee sheet. Play to be from the Black Tees only.

9. MENS' MID-WEEK MONTHLY MEDAL:

To be played on the third Wednesday of each month.
Is a multi-Tee competition.

The best score returned by a golfing member on that day shall be the Medal winner. In the event of a tie between two or more players, the GA count back system will be used to determine the winner.

Is Open to all male golf members of all golf categories Full Financial Golf, Golf & Bowls members, Introductory, Junior, Country Members and Golf & Go Members of Club Tocumwal Limited. Winners of the Mid-week Monthly Medal for the current year shall be eligible to play off for the Graeme Sharp Shield. To be played on Wednesday 18th November, 2026.

In the event of a tie the winner will be decided by the count back system.

10. SINGLES KNOCKOUT:

Play will be stroke and is open to all male Full Financial Golf, Golf & Bowls members and Golf & Go members of Club Tocumwal Limited.

The qualifying round will be played on Saturday 8th August 2026 with the top eight (8) NETT scores to qualify for the Match Play competition.

Matches MUST be played on or before the dates specified in the 2026 CT syllabus. The Matchplay FINAL will be played on Saturday 5th September at 11.30am.

Each match must be played from the BLACK PLATES.

11. Players are to report to the **starter at least 20 minutes prior to their starting time.**

12. All competition games are covered by the R&A Rules of Golf.

A Medley Competition is a competition set for all golfers regardless of gender. Grades are decided by the field size on the day. A Multi-Tee Competition is every club competition. Unless the competition is a shotgun start or a special event. Players choose their colour tee prior to starting their round at registration. Daily Handicaps are calculated by the slope ratings of the course and colour tee. Minimum Player numbers required (excluding medley comps eight (8) in total) to register in the comp to hold a competition at Club Tocumwal.

Womens' daily comp - Three (3) players are required to register in the competition.

Mens' daily comp - Eight (8) players are required to register in the competition

3 Stroke play rounds – For A, B, C and D Grades. In the event of a tie all grades will be decided by a hole-by-hole sudden death playoff. Open to all female Full Financial Golf, Golf & Bowls members and Golf & Go members of Club Tocumwal Limited. Order of holes to be decided by the committee.

One 54-hole trophy per person – gross takes precedence.

Conditions of Entry for the CT Club Championships will be available on the Club Tocumwal website from July 2026.

WOMENS' MID-WEEK CHAMPIONSHIPS

The Mid-week Championship is a Stableford Only. Grades will be determined after the first round of the event and is Open to all female golf members of all golf categories Full Financial Golf, Golf & Bowls members, Introductory, Country Members, Juniors and Golf & Go Members of Club Tocumwal Limited. The championships will be played over three (3) rounds of Stableford play on the days allotted to the event in May 2026. Play to be from the Green Tees only for all three rounds. In the event of a tie all grades will be decided by the count-back system approved by GA. Conditions of Entry for the Mid-week Club Championships will be available on the Club Tocumwal website from March 2026.

- Tee times available to women to book on all three (3) days of the championship.
- Daily events conducted in conjunction with the championships in all divisions, (determined on the day).

CLUB FOURSOMES CHAMPIONSHIP:

27-hole Foursomes Championship is open to all Full Financial Golf, Golf & Bowls members and Golf & Go members of Club Tocumwal Limited. In the event of a tie in the Gross event, a sudden death play-off will occur on holes nominated by the Committee. Net event to be decided by the countback process.

MONTHLY MEDAL:

Open to all Full Financial Golf, Golf & Bowls members and Golf & Go members of Club Tocumwal Limited. Monthly medal to be played for on the day allotted each month, off the Green markers. Monthly Medals for November, December, January, and February may be held as a Stableford event.

A count-back will be held in the event of a tie.

WOMENS' SUNDAY MONTHLY MEDAL:

To be played on the First Sunday of each month. Is a multi-Tee and Stableford competition only. The best score returned by a golfing member on that day shall be the Medal winner. In the event of a tie between two

or more players, the GA count back system will be used to determine the winner. Is Open to all female golf members of all golf categories Full Financial Golf, Golf & Bowls members, Introductory, Junior, Country Members and Golf & Go Members of Club Tocumwal Limited. Winners of the Womens' Sunday Monthly Medal for the current year shall be eligible to play off for the WSM Medal. To be played on Sunday November 8th, 2026. In the event of a tie the winner will be decided by the count back system.

STAR MEDAL:

Open to all Full Financial Golf, Golf & Bowls members and Golf & Go members of Club Tocumwal Limited.

The Star Medallist shall be played on the day allotted and time. Tuesday, October 8th, 2026.

Winners of the monthly medal for the current year shall be eligible to play for the Star Medal. A countback will be held in the event of a tie.

WOMENS' SINGLES KNOCKOUT:

18 HOLE STROKE PLAY - Eight players to qualify for Match play. To be played on the normal competition day. Final to be played on the Tuesday indicated in the syllabus. Matches MUST be played on or before the dates specified in the 2026 CT syllabus.

SEITER'S TIMBER SHIELD:

4BBB Stableford - Eight pairs to qualify for Match play. Matches MUST be played on or before the dates specified in the 2026 CT syllabus. The Final will be played on Tuesday June 23th, 2026.

PRESIDENT'S TROPHY:

Aggregate of best 6 net scores during Tuesday. Handicap 27-45. as at the first monthly medal round.

CAPTAIN'S TROPHY:

The best 6 net scores during the womens' golf calendar year played on MM day. Handicap 0-26. as at the first monthly medal round.

PUTTING TROPHY:

Donated by the late Joan Morey. Aggregate of the best 6 scores to count. To be played on each Monthly Medal Tuesday.

NEAREST THE PIN:

To be conducted on all competition days. Number of daily NTP's are subject to player numbers.

ECLECTIC, BIRDIES AND GOBBLERS' COMPETITIONS:

Run in conjunction with Tuesday competitions.

GOLF VICTORIA SILVER SPOON:

Competition over 4 rounds, best net score and ties to play off in the 5th and final round. Lowest net score wins the spoon. Spoon winner will be eligible to play for a case of spoons at the State Final on a date to be confirmed.
