HOUSE AND GENERAL RULES

DRESS:

Men and Ladies are requested to take pride in the club and maintain a responsible standard in respect to their attire in the club house and on the greens. All members are requested to read the dress regulations displayed in the club house foyer.

CLUB SUBSCRIPTIONS:

Subscriptions are due by 1st September. Any member whose subscription is in arrears shall be debarred from all club privileges.

COMPLAINTS:

All complaints shall be made to the General Bowls Committee. The complaint must be in writing so as to avoid misinterpretation.

PLAYING ETIQUETTE

During Gameplay:

- At the mat end: When not delivering a bowl, stand at least 2 metres behind the mat and within the confines of the rink.
- Distractions: Avoid actions that could distract the bowler, like chatting or moving in their peripheral vision. Be mindful of players on adjacent rinks as well.
- Delivery: Watch your bowl until it stops, then promptly return behind the mat.
- Good Bowls: Acknowledge and commend both your teammates' good shots and your opponents' exceptional ones.
- "Fluke" Shots: Be honest and admit when you play a lucky shot, and remember this when your opponent has a similar stroke of luck.
- Unlucky Shots: Never applaud a "lucky" shot, as it's essentially a poor bowl with a good result.
- Riding Opponent's Bowls: Do not encourage an opponent's bowl to move towards a better position for your team, or applaud such an outcome.
- Excuses: Avoid making excuses for poor play based on green conditions or weather, as these affect all players equally.
- Moving to the Head: Follow the last player to play, stay within your rink, and walk close to the centre to avoid disturbing other players.

General Conduct:

- Sportsmanship: Players must adhere to the rules, avoid actions that bring the game into disrepute, and maintain a sporting manner towards everyone involved.
- Respect: Be respectful of officials, coaches, other players, and spectators.
- No Contact: Avoid inappropriate or physical contact with players or officials.

Club Etiquette:

- The proposer of a new member should act as a mentor.
- Members should be silent during official announcements.
- Show respect for the club's administrators.
- Returning Items: Return borrowed personal items to their owners
- Silence: Be silent when officials are making announcements.
- Starting Positions: The third player can be at the head with the skip until their turn to play, while the lead and second players must start at the mat end.
- Moving to the Head (Conditions of Play): Leads can move after the second player's second bowl, seconds and thirds after their second bowl, and skips after each of their bowls.

SOME BASIC RULES YOU SHOULD KNOW

- Mat Placement: The first to play places the mat on the centre line at least 2 metres from the ditch and up to the desired length as dictated by the skip.
- Foot Faulting: Before delivery a player must be standing on the mat with all or at least part of one foot on the mat. At the moment they deliver the jack or a bowl the player must have all or part of one foot on or above the mat.
- Jack / Bowl Length: A jack must travel 21 metres to be legal while a bowl must travel 14 metres to be in play.
- Jack Delivery: If the jack is improperly delivered the opposition may reposition the mat and deliver the jack but not play first. If the jack is delivered improperly by both leads the jack is placed at the 2 metre mark and the first to play may reposition the mat.
- Position on Rink: Players at the mat end who are not delivering a bowl should stand at least 1 metre behind the mat. Players at the head end who are not controlling play should stand behind the jack.
- Playing Wrong Bowl: Replace with correct bowl.
- Playing out of Turn: Opposition skip has choice: a) may stop the bowl; b) leave it and have two bowls played to restore proper sequence; c) reset disturbed head and restore proper sequence; d) leave disturbed head and play two bowls or; e) declare dead end.
- Rink Possession: Possession of the rink belongs to the player or team whose bowl is being played.
- Determining score: Bowls should not be moved until the number of shots has been agreed upon by the vice or skip.
- Objects on the green: No objects should be placed on the bank, the green or in the ditch to help a player.

CONDITIONS OF PLAY MAJOR EVENTS 2025/2026

- Events will be played under the laws of the Game of Bowls.
- All entries will close at 4pm 8 days before the scheduled date for the first round
- Event entry fees MUST be paid at time of entering.
- Matches will be played on/from the start date in the Syllabus. Club Championship Men's and Ladies' Singles and Pairs must be completed before entries close for the Region Champion of Champion Pairs on 9 February 2026 and State Champion of Champion singles on 23 February 2026.
- Full bowls uniform is optional for events but both players and markers to wear full bowls uniform for finals.
- Any dispute should be promptly referred to the Match Committee.
- Dead ends will be replayed.
- All events are a knockout competition where winners proceed to the next round.
- Multiple rounds of competition may be played on the same day.
- A two end roll up will be allowed provided it is completed prior to the scheduled start time.
- Any player/team arriving after the scheduled start time will lose the right to a roll up.
- Any player/team arriving more than 30 minutes after the scheduled start time will forfeit the match.
- The Match Committee reserves the right to change conditions of play.
